- _____ Preadmission ATI Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) – a score of 63% or greater is required. Must complete 14 college credits before taking the TEAS prior to April 1st that precedes your planned August enrollment.

The following are required to enter the First Year Nursing course:

1. GPA must be > 2.5 for prerequisite college courses.
2. A grade of C- or better in A&P I & II within 5 years of the student's August enrollment.
3. The remaining enrollment requirements (no time limit) require a grade of C- or better.

For RN to BSN/MSN options, it is strongly advised that you contact the advisor for the College you plan to attend before you take any of the additional courses.
